We have the village putting in \$7500 and guarantee donation of \$5000 right now with more coming in. Jen has snow cone vendor who might be interested, the Café is supposed to be a vendor also.

In order to get a permit we required a letter from the police and fire that they would be there, and Chris W. was able to obtain those letters. So it appears all is in order to go ahead.

We have 3 out houses and a hand wash station coming in Jen is getting garbage cans, Union Hill will donate garbage bags, Bill will look at the one broken rail on the fence, Michell will have safety tape for Chris D. to tape off town.

Jen Bauer was asked by Grant to be the clerk. Bill motioned to have Jen take over as clerk in the next two months Chris W. seconded the motion the motion carried.

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Treasurer report: \$244080.80 John motioned to approve the treasurer report. Mitch seconded the motion and the motion carried.

Bills to pay: Bill motioned to pay the bills Mitchell seconded it and the motion carried.
